1. It Helps Me _____ My Life Around God

“Christ’s love has the first and last word in everything we do. Our firm decision is to work from this focused center...” 2 Corinthians 5:14 (Mes)

2. It Helps Me _____ With Other Believers

3. It Helps Me _____ Spiritual Maturity

“Christ’s Body is fitted together perfectly. As each part does its own special work, it helps the other parts grow, so that the whole Body is healthy and growing and full of love.” Ephesians 4:16 (NLT)

“Their purpose is to prepare God’s people to serve, and to build up the Body of Christ... until we become mature, and measure up to Christ, who is the standard.” Ephesians 4:12-13 (GW)

“God wants us to grow up, to know the whole truth and tell it in love—like Christ in everything.” Ephesians 4:15a (Mes)

“Don’t lose a minute in building on what you’ve been given, complementing your basic faith with good character, spiritual understanding, alert discipline, passionate patience, reverent wonder, warm friendliness, and generous love, each dimension fitting into and developing the others.” 2 Peter 1:5 (Mes)
