2. No Matter What Others Say About Me, _____

“..Jesus looked up at Zacchaeus and called him by name, ‘Zacchaeus!’ He said.” Luke 19:5b (NLT)

“For we are God’s masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so that we can do the good things He planned for us long ago.” Ephesians 2:10 (NLT)

3. No Matter What I’ve Done, _____

“..He said, Quick! Come down! For I am going to be a guest in your home today!” Luke 19:5c (LB)

“All the people saw this and began to complain, Jesus is staying with a sinner!” Luke 19:7 (NCV)

How He Responded To Jesus

“Zacchaeus hurried down and welcomed Him with great joy.” Luke 19:6 (GN)

“Zacchaeus stood before the Lord and said, ‘I will give half my wealth to the poor, Lord, and if I have cheated people on their taxes, I will give them back four times as much!’ Jesus responded, ‘Salvation has come to this home today!’” Luke 19:8-9 (NLT)
