

God Is Ready To Help

Series: God Is...

How To Face Your Challenges – 2 Chronicles 20:1-30

Step 1: Turn To God For The Help You Need

“The armies of the Moabites, Ammonites, and the Meunites declared war... The King was afraid, so he decided to ask the Lord what to do.” vs. 1-3 (NCV)

Step 2: Talk To God About Your Situation

“The King went and stood before them and prayed aloud...” vs. 5b (GN)

- **Remember How Awesome God Is**

“Are You not the God who is in heaven? You rule over all the kingdoms of the nations. Power and might are in Your hand, and no one can withstand You.” vs. 6 (NIV)

- **Remember What God Has Done In The Past**

“Didn’t You drive out those who lived in this land when Your people arrived?” vs. 7 (NLT)

- **Ask God For Help**

“O God, won’t You stop them?” vs. 12a (NLT)

Step 3: Trust God To Help You

“We are powerless against this mighty army that is about to attack us. We do not know what to do, but we are looking to You for help.” vs. 12b (NLT)

“This is what the Lord says: ‘Do not be afraid! Do not be discouraged by this mighty army, for the battle is not yours, but God’s.’” vs. 15b (NLT)

“You won’t need to fight in this battle. Just stand strong in your places, and you will see the Lord save you.” vs. 17a (NCV)

“Have faith in the Lord your God, and you will stand strong. Have faith in His prophets, and you will succeed.” vs. 20 (NCV)

How Does This Story End?

“The king appointed singers to walk ahead of the army, singing to the Lord and praising Him... This is what they sang: ‘Give thanks to the Lord for His faithful love endures forever!’” vs. 21 (NLT)

“At the moment they began to sing and to praise, the Lord caused the armies of Ammon, Moab, and Mount Seir to start fighting among themselves, and they destroyed each other!” vs. 22 (LB)

“When the surrounding kingdoms heard that the Lord Himself had fought against the enemies of Israel, the fear of God came over them. So the kingdom was at peace, for God had given him rest on every side.” vs. 29-30 (NLT)
