3 Ways to Grow Your Spiritual Leadership

1. Set an Example

1 Timothy 4:12 (BSB)

"Let no one despise your youth, but set an example for the believers in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, in purity."

1 Timothy 4:7-8 (BSB)

"7 ...Train yourself for godliness. 8 For physical exercise is of limited value, but godliness is valuable in every way, holding promise for the present life and for the one to come."

2. Stick with the Basics & Prove Your Progress

1 Timothy 4:13, 15 (BSB)

"13 Until I come, devote yourself to the public reading of Scripture, to exhortation, and to teaching. ... 15 Be diligent in these matters and absorbed in them, so that your progress will be evident to all."

2 Timothy 2:1-2 (BSB)

"1 You therefore, my child, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus. 2 And the things that you have heard me say among many witnesses, entrust these to faithful men who will be qualified to teach others as well."

3. **Stoke the Fire within You**

1 Timothy 4:14 (BSB)

"Do not neglect the gift that is in you, which was given you through the prophecy spoken over you at the laying on of the hands of the elders."

Romans 12:11 (BSB)

"Do not let your zeal subside; keep your spiritual fervor, serving the Lord."
